



How You Can Help Wild Horses

We share your concern for wild horses. Unfortunately, a very sad new chapter has opened and the first documented blood has been shed by the Burns rider. We have just learned that six wild horses were sold by the government and then slaughtered at a Belgian-owned slaughter plant in Illinois (Cavel International, in Dekalb) . An individual, Dustin Herbert of Meeker, OK, claiming to want the horses for a church youth program, bought the horses Friday (4/15) and they were sold to Cavel and killed on Monday (4/18).

We must stop the commercial sale of our wild horses immediately...

1. Please call and email Secretary of Interior Gale Norton --
Phone: 202-208-3100/7351 and E-Mail: exsec@ios.doi.gov
Ask her to immediately stop the sale of wild horses through the Bureau of Land Management -- and to order the agency to draft, submit for public comment and then institute regulations that safeguard our wild horses.

Note: Phone calls are best – with a follow up E-mail – to be sure your message is heard!

2. Contact your federal legislators to urge them to pass
H.R. 297/S. 576 (ask both of your senators) immediately to stop the slaughter of our wild horses and burros. Go to www.AHDF.org or call (202) 224-3121 to find your federal legislators.

3. Please circulate to everyone you know -- it is imperative we get federal legislation passed to prevent any more of our precious wild horses from going to slaughter!

4. Write short impassioned letters to the editors of your papers and any horse publications urging your US Rep and Senators to cosponsor (by name) now.

5. Send us any contact info for your local: papers, radio, TV. Numbers and emails are best. Thanks!

6. Get THIS INFO AND OUR SAMPLE LETTERS (SEE ALERTS), TO your state's horse rescues, shelters (humane societies).....

7. Put up flyers in your tack and feed shops.

8. Send \$ to help us put up bill boards in a number of key states. Note it as Funds For Wild Horses in any PayPal donation or check.

9. Buy one of our new car/trailer magnets that says: Save Our Wild Horses Before Its Too late. They are just \$6 and are very noticeable.
